4.   <sup>9</sup>I have no need  
      to take of thee at all  
Goats of thy fold,  
      or calf out of thy stall.  
<sup>10</sup>For all the beasts  
      are mine within the woods:  
On thousand hills  
      cattle are mine own goods.  
<sup>11</sup>I know for mine  
      all birds that are on mountains:  
All beasts are mine  
      which haunt the fields and fountains.
5.   <sup>12</sup>Hungry if I were,  
      I would not thee it tell:  
For all is mine,  
      that in this world doth dwell.  
<sup>13</sup>Eat I the flesh  
      of great bulls or bullocks?  
Or drink the blood  
      of goats and of the flocks?  
<sup>14</sup>Offer to God  
      praise and hearty thanksgiving  
And pay thy vows  
      unto God ever-living.
6.   <sup>15</sup>Call upon me,  
      when troubled thou shalt be,  
Then will I help,  
      and thou shalt honour me.  
<sup>16</sup>To the wicked  
      thus sayeth th'eternal God,  
Why dost thou preach  
      my laws and hestes<sup>17</sup> abroad,  
Seeing thou hast  
      them with thy mouth abused,  
<sup>17</sup>And hatest to be  
      by discipline reformed?
7.   My words, I say,  
      thou dost reject and hate.  
<sup>18</sup>If that thou see  
      a thief, as with thy mate,  
Thou runnest with him,  
      and so your praise do seek,  
And art all one  
      with bauds and ruffians eke.  
<sup>19</sup>Thou givest thyself  
      to backbite and to slander,  
And how thy tongue  
      deceiveth, it is a wonder.
8.   <sup>20</sup>Thou sitteth musing,  
      thy brother how to blame,  
And how to put  
      thy mother's son to shame.  
<sup>21</sup>These things thou didst:  
      and whilst I held my tongue,  
Thou didst me judge,  
      (because I stayed so long)  
Like to thyself:  
      yet though I kept long silence,  
Once shalt thou feel  
      of thy wrongs just recompense.
9.   <sup>22</sup>Consider this,  
      ye that forget the Lord,  
And fear not when  
      he threateneth with his word,  
Lest without help  
      I spoil you as a prey,  
<sup>23</sup>But he that thanks  
      offereth, praiseth me aye,  
Sayeth the Lord God:  
      and he that walketh this trace,  
I will him teach  
      God's saving health to embrace.
